

## CHECKLIST FOR AUTHORS

During the preparation of the manuscript, the authors must follow the following items which summarizes both the publication policy and the writing rules of the journal: Montes Taurus Journal of Pure and Applied Mathematics (MTJPAM).

<b>1.</b>	The language of manuscripts must be in English.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>2.</b>	All authors guarantee that the manuscript is an original manuscript, prepared by the stated authors and the manuscript has not been published and also submitted elsewhere before.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>3.</b>	All authors guarantee that the manuscript is not being considered for publication simultaneously elsewhere and will not be submitted for such review while under review by Montes Taurus Journal of Pure and Applied Mathematics (MTJPAM).	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>4.</b>	All authors guarantee that they do not use any illegal method or material during the research, they have obtained all legal permissions regarding the research, and that they are responsible for this.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>5.</b>	All authors know that the article cannot be accepted unless if the similarity rate of the article is below 30% [iThenticate].	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>6.</b>	<b>6.1.</b> The first page should contain the full title in sentence case (namely involving capitalizing only the first word and any proper nouns).	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>6.2.</b> The title of the manuscript must be concise, descriptive and informative.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>6.3.</b> The title do not include special mathematical symbols and characters.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>7.</b>	<b>7.1.</b> All authors' full names and surnames (without any abbreviation) must be given separately.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>7.2.</b> The corresponding author must be specified.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>7.3.</b> If the manuscript was prepared jointly with different authors, Corresponding Author is responsible for ensuring that each author is informed about all other forms, correspondence, interviews.	<input type="checkbox"/>

	<b>7.4.</b> All authors have seen and approved the manuscript as submitted.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>8.</b>	<b>8.1.</b> Affiliation, mailing address, and e-mail addresses of each author should be included into the manuscript.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>8.2.</b> If any, the ORCID iDs of all authors should also be inserted into the manuscript, or the cover letter.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>9.</b>	The abstract should be written to include the main purpose, results, motivation and method of the article and should not exceed 300 words. In other words, the abstract should be organized to stay in the first page of the manuscript.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>10.</b>	2010 Mathematics Subject Classification (MSC2010) numbers, involving the annual index associated with MathSciNet/Mathematical Reviews and Zentralblatt MATH (zbMATH). (see: <a href="https://mathscinet.ams.org/mathscinet/msc/msc2020.html">https://mathscinet.ams.org/mathscinet/msc/msc2020.html</a> )	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>11.</b>	The numbers of keywords must be at most 8 keywords and/or phrases and at least 2 keywords and/or phrases.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>12.</b>	Figures and graphics, if included, should be prepared suitable for photographic reproduction.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>13.</b>	The MTJPAM prefers graphics produced electronically and compiled in the EPS format.	<input type="checkbox"/>
<b>14.</b>	<b>14.1.</b> All authors may express their thanks for the financial support and etc. in the section “Acknowledgments”.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>14.2.</b> The authors must write author contributions in the section “Author Contributions”.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>14.3.</b> If available, the authors may write the conflicts of interest in the section “Conflicts of Interest”. All authors should disclose any conflict of interest that may have influenced either the conduct or the presentation of the research.	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>14.4.</b> In the section “Funding (Financial Disclosure)”, names of funding organizations should be written in full (if available).	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<b>15.1.</b> The items in the reference section should be ordered according to the alphabetical order of the family names of the authors and numbered numerically as [1], [2], ...	<input type="checkbox"/>

	<p><b>15.2.</b> In the references list, during arranging the form of the references, the journal's abbreviations must be organized compatible with the list entitled "Abbreviations of Names of Serials" published by MathSciNet-American Mathematical Society (see: <a href="https://mathscinet.ams.org/msnhtml/serials.pdf">https://mathscinet.ams.org/msnhtml/serials.pdf</a>). If there is no abbreviation of the relevant journal in the list, you can write the abbreviations announced on the web page of the relevant journal.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
	<p><b>15.3.</b> The citations should be given via “<code>\cite{label}</code>” command during the preparation of LaTeX file, not given in square brackets manually.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>

Thus, manuscripts must be prepared and submitted in PDF format which is prepared compatible with the TeX style of the journal.
